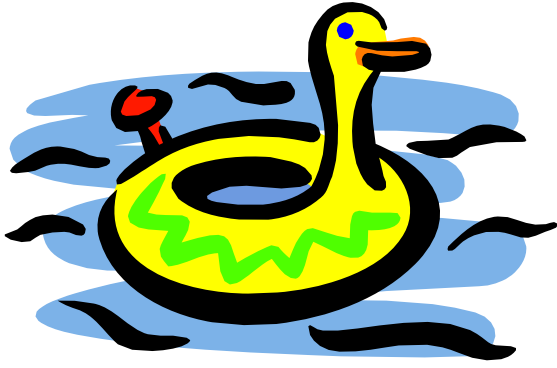


Moving Made Easy! For kids!
